PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Virtual Greetings!

It has been a year since the beginning of the Covid-19 pandemic and a worldwide lockdown. These words would have sounded like a mad Sci-Fi movie not that long ago, and still, here we are, unable to work, travel, or see family and friends as we would see it fit. I know some of you lost some close ones to this pandemic. We had SMMP members who passed away in 2020. Our thoughts are to all. We all know someone who was affected, one way or the other. Some loss their jobs, some museums are still closed, and a few might not even reopen. It is a tough time for humanity, culture and art.

At the same time, we adapted to the situation. We worked from home, and still, we managed to stay connected with colleagues, friends and family thanks to the wonders of the internet. At this point, it is our daily routine to have online meetings and organize our work day remotely, even if some of us are partially or totally back into their institution. In the meantime, we found other ways to communicate with our public, to help scientists with our collections. We have seen with this time more and more online content appearing on museum websites, including digital access to collections, and virtual panoramic or guided tours. The use of Social Media in the museum community exploded, and the number of people turning to virtually exploring museums increased significantly. It might just have been our chance to reach to a new community of people that we might never have reached otherwise.

The SMMP joined this worldwide effort in staying virtually connected. With the Sainte-Marie show not happening, Mineral Talks LIVE (weekly Wednesday show) came alive and still carries on, created in partnership with Blue Cap Production (Bryan Swoboda), Harvard University (Raquel Alonso-Perez) and the SMMP (Eloïse Gaillou & Raquel). We had our first SMMP virtual meeting synchronized with the Munich show at the beginning of November 2020, and the first virtual Annual General Meeting in February 2021.

As our by-laws were revamped to add the virtual component and comply with genderneutrality, the SMMP formed different committees following the by-laws (see below). Their role is essential in separating the different components of the SMMP: membership, education and planning, and nomination for the election. You already heard from these different committees, and you will some more in the near future, especially regarding your thoughts about an (online) workshop and adding social media content.

Also, as we had our first online election, I am pleased to report as your new President for 2021! I wanted to acknowledge all the great work conducted by Katherine Dunnell over the past 5 years as President. She drew the SMMP in a new and forward vision. We will continue implementing her work on a SMMP mission statement that all museums worldwide could use to support their collections and institutions. I am also happy to continue working with Anna, Raquel, Ryan, and Vera, and welcome new Board members Gabriela, Henrik, and Tom. Of course, this includes Caroline who created the new version of our website.
